For the Awareness of All and to Enlighten Society Further Important Notice

This is to inform that the admission process for free residential girl students from Class V to Class VIII for the 2026–27 academic year at 'Mukti Shikha', a non-profit and completely free ashram, is currently ongoing. Priority will be given to socially and economically disadvantaged or orphaned girls who are interested in pursuing education up to at least the Higher Secondary level in a residential environment.

Admission Conditions

- 1. Health:** The applicant must be mentally and physically fit. If any prior record of physical or mental illness is discovered later, the application or residential status may be cancelled.
- 2. Residence:** The applicant's permanent address must be at least 15 km away from the ashram premises.
- 3. Family Income:** The applicant's annual family income must be below ₹60,000 (sixty thousand).
- 4. Age Limit:** The student's age must be between 10 and 13 years.
- 5. Educational Qualification:** The student must currently be studying between Class IV and Class VII in a recognized school.

Admission Procedure

The entire admission process will be offline. Forms will be available at the 'Mukti Shikha' Rajarhat Ashram premises and at previously mentioned collection points.

Form Distribution Timing: 8:00 a.m. – 12:00 noon | Days: Monday, Wednesday, Friday, and Sunday

Documents Required for Form Collection

- 1. Student's Aadhaar Card:** One Xerox copy (original must be shown).
- 2. Guardian's Government-Approved ID Proof:** Aadhaar Card / PAN Card / Voter ID — one Xerox copy (original must be shown).
- 3. Permanent Residence Proof (Student and Guardian):** Aadhaar Card or Ration Card — one Xerox copy (original must be shown).
- 4. Previous Year's School Report Card:** Original and one Xerox copy to be submitted along with the application.
- 5. Photographs:** Two recent stamp/passport-size photographs of the student.
- 6. School Leaving Certificate / Transfer Certificate:** Original must be submitted before admission.

Selection Process

After the guardian submits the student's application, members of the ashram's housing committee will visit the applicant's residence and evaluate eligibility. Based on this assessment, a list of selected students will be published 15 days prior to admission.

The decision of the 'Mukti Shikha' Ashram Committee will be final and binding regarding all admission matters.

Note

If any discrepancy is found in the submitted documents, the application may be rejected.
